Alan will be talking about several aspects of bee health, including EFB, AFB, resistant varroa and the likely ways we may be able to keep it in check. Alan will be returning later in the year as part of the IPM Workshop planned for 17th April.

This will make an ideal primer for a theme that seems likely to dominate our thinking over the coming months - just what will we do when resistant varroa arrives in Kent?
