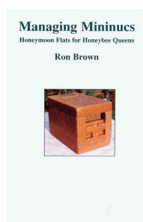
**John H ATKINSON.** *Background to Bee Breeding.* **£26.** The best in depth English volume on breeding which will be recognised, over time, as a classic



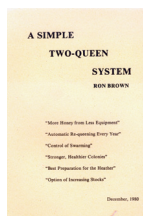
