Hazel Street Bee Farm

Directions: **Via the M20** - at J7, take the A249 northbound and, after about 5 miles turn Right, signposted South Green & Bicknor. If you miss the turn, don't worry, carry on to the roundabout and get it heading back!

**Via the M2**, at J5 take the A249 South (towards Maidstone). Take the 2<sup>nd</sup> turning on the left, signposted South Green & Bicknor. Both routes are now the same : follow the narrow lane, keep left at the fork and travel through South Green. At the next cross roads, turn right towards Hazel Street. Follow the twisty road until you arrive at Hazel Street Bee Farm. Bright yellow Medway BKA signs will point the way. Plenty of car parking.
